

### Join the Advocacy Team

The CGE Advocacy Committee held its first parent meetup in September, bringing parents and professionals together to discuss ways to support all students at CGE.

### **Playground Improvements**

The district has proposed using pea gravel in all three playground areas as a drainage solution, but the PTA strongly opposes this due to safety concerns, ongoing maintenance needs, and the lack of ADA compliance.

We are advocating for more sustainable solutions, such as turf or padded rubber surfacing. These options require significant sponsorships or additional fundraising. If you're a business owner or community member who can help, we'd love to hear from you!

### **Kits for Inclusive Learning**

Our PTA advocacy group recently assembled teacher kits to support students with diverse learning styles and needs. These kits include a variety of tools, such as reading strips and pointers for readers with dyslexia, sensory toys, timers, feelings flashcards, and fidget tools. By providing these resources, we aim to help teachers create more inclusive and engaging learning environments. Thank supporting this initiative!

### **FUNDRAISING UPDATES**


#### **BOOSTERHON FUN RUN**
